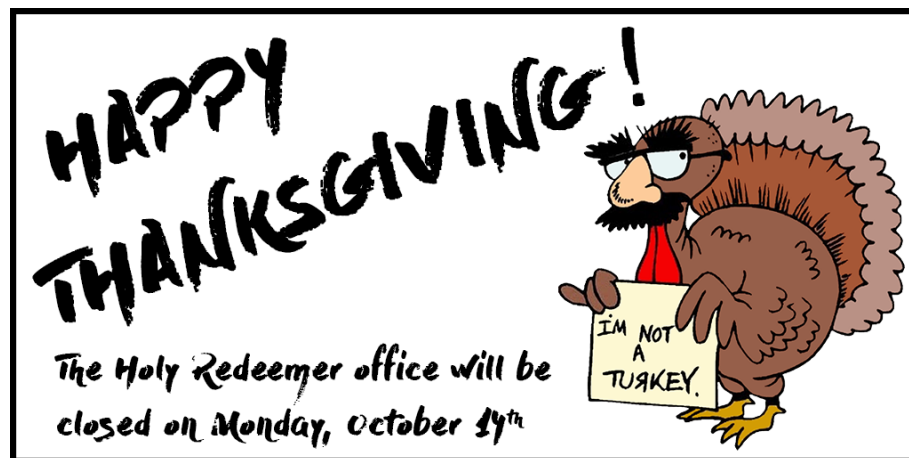
Next Sunday there will be a collection for World Mission Sunday
