Frequently Asked Questions About Alpha:

What if I want to go and I don't have a way to get there? If you would like to attend and the only thing stopping you is that you need a lift to-and-from please give us a call and we will try to help.

Eleven weeks is a long time and I plan on being away for some of it, can I still participate? Yes, we provide a weekly handout, and we send everyone access to the video's; if you miss a session here and there it is very easy to get caught up.

Is the food free? Yes, however as with everything free we ask for a free will offering towards to end of Alpha.

I have a friend who is not a Catholic; is it OK to bring them? Yes, Alpha is not specific to any Christian demonization. It is also a great program for people who don't go to church and are curious or on the edge of what they believe.

Will I be put on the spot if I am quiet? No, participation in the discussion is purely optional.

I would like to register however I do not have an email address? This is not a problem, please let one of us know. Or just show up.

What if I forget to register? Just show up. We will not turn anyone away. However, if you can let us know in advance, please do, so we can make sure we have enough food for everyone.

What if I cannot make it to the first session? We can take new people up to the third session. After that you can come-and-see what we are all about and eat with us however you will not be able to participate in the group discussion.

Do I need to bring anything? No, we provide handouts and pens.

I have food allergies and eating away from home is hard? If you let us know about your food allergies, we will make sure that we prepare something that you can eat.

Why does it have to start at 6:30pm? I usually eat much earlier? We have received this feedback and have considered moving it to an earlier start time. We chose this time in consideration for people who work and find it difficult to attend if the start time is earlier than 6:30pm.
