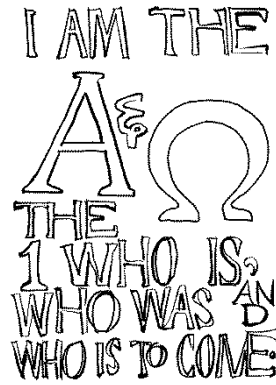

For the poor, especially families with children, and for seniors, who lack the necessities of life. We pray to the Lord.

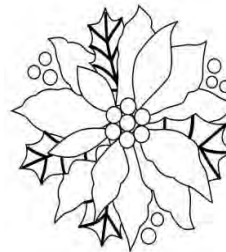
For our relatives and friends in the United States who will gather with family this week for Thanksgiving. We pray to the Lord.
