VOTIVE CANDLES - Unfortunately, we are going to have to stop replenishing the votive candle stands at the back of the church. Children are being allowed to light candles unattended, which poses a serious risk to them and those around them. In the last few weeks a child nearly suffered a burn due to lack of supervision.

The other issue we are facing is that votive candles cost the parish a substantial amount of money every year. However, most candles being lit at the back of the church are not being paid for. We recently paid over \$1,800 for candles and only brought in \$1,000.

The candle stand at the front of the church will continue to be used. With safety in mind, children will only be permitted to light candles when accompanied by a parent.
